Development Application DA19/0759 at Lot 101 DP 749088, at 54 – 50 Henry Street Penrith - Business Identification Signage - Erection of Two Wall Mounted Business Identification Signs.

Panel Consideration/Reasons for the Decision

The Panel had regard to the assessment report prepared by Council Officers and the following plans;
