STATEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS IN SUPPORT OF A DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION WHICH SEEKS APPROVAL FOR THE DEMOLITION OF EXISTING SINGLE STOREY DWELLINGS, DETACHED GARAGES & VARIOUS OUTBUILDINGS AT 118-120 STATION STREET PENRITH

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This Statement of Environmental Effects has been prepared in support of a Development Application which seeks approval to demolish the existing single storey dwellings, detached garages & various outbuildings located on LOTS 4 & 5 IN DP 112466 & LOT 6 DP 1003862 (No 118-120 Station Street).

The existing structures are to be removed so that the site can be used as a development site.

2.0 THE PROPOSAL

The Development Application seeks approval to demolish the existing single storey dwellings, detached garages & various outbuildings on the site.
