

STATEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS

This Statement of Environmental Effects accompanies an application for Development Consent for the abovementioned site, containing Bunnings Warehouse and associated car parking.

The proposal is for a canopy to the timber trade entry and the extension of the bagged goods canopy, as detailed in the attached A3 plans. The canopies are proposed to provide shelter from the elements for customers and staff.

There is no change proposed to any operational matters including no change to the hours of operation, staff numbers, goods or deliveries.

The development is in keeping with the character of the area and does not impact on any item of heritage or cultural significance.
