EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN 2018

Prior to every performance starting the Ringmaster will have made the following announcement
“ In the unlikely event that there is an emergency and we ask you to leave the big top, simply go to the nearest end of the seating that you are in and proceed to the Exit and go through it and move to the Assembly Area at the front of the Big Top and remain there until further instructed”

In the event of an emergency situation being called the following procedure will commence

- 1 The person in charge shall instigate the warning to all circus personnel including the Ringmaster
- 2 The Person in charge will instruct the ring and tent crew where they are to be situated to assist patrons from the circus tent
- 3 The Ringmaster will then inform the patrons that are inside the tent, by the PA System or by voice if power is not running, to evacuate the tent (if this is the desired intention).
- 4 The Ringmaster shall continue to direct the movement of patrons from the tent with the assistance of circus staff who then direct patrons them to the Assembly Area usually at front of tent
- 5 The ringmaster may also indicate to the Patrons the preferred Exit points
- 6 The ring and tent crew while assisting the patrons to exit the tent will also keep patrons clear of any particular hazard that may have just been created
- 7 Ring and tent crew will assist by showing the way and only physically assist if prams or wheelchairs are impeding others from exiting or if assistance is required by those persons with the prams or wheelchairs
- 8 Once all patrons are cleared from tent all staff members to be accounted for.
- 9 In the event of injury to any persons including patrons or tent crew and medical attention is required the First Aid personnel to assist
- 10 If Ambulance is required it shall be called for also Police and Workcover to be notified as well
- 11 Accident Injury Form to be filled in as soon as practical
- 12 A summary of all aspects of need for Emergency Evacuation to be compiled as soon as practical

G 2 The holder of this authority is required to comply with the 'General Standards for Exhibiting Animals in New South Wales'.

G 3 The holder of an authority must cause the authority to be at all times publicly displayed in a prominent position at the premises at which the animals concerned are being displayed.

G 4 That any proposed changes to animal accommodation are submitted to Department of Primary Industries for approval before being carried out.

G 5 Animals shall be kept at the above address when not being exhibited at a mobile establishment or being transported to or from an exhibition at a mobile establishment.

G 6 The authority holder shall not display, or keep for display more than 30 animals (this includes animals that are displayed or kept for display under a separate authority issued to the holder under the Exhibited Animals Protection Act, 1986).

G 7 The holder of this authority is required to comply with the 'Standards for Exhibiting Animals at Mobile Establishments in New South Wales' except where the holder is displaying animals, or keeping them for display, at a circus at which times the authority holder must comply with the 'Standards for Exhibiting Circus Animals in New South Wales'.
