Purpose

Nepean Regional Security (NRS) has been engaged to provide external (perimeter) security services to the Defqon 1 music event to be held at the Sydney International Regatta Centre, Saturday 19th September 2016.

It is understood that there will be approximately 25,000 – 27,000 customers to the festival on the event day. Relevant ticket sales information will be provided closer to the event.

Additional security services have also been requested for the night prior and after to the main event.

Nepean Regional Security is the security provider for asset protection and perimeter security for the venue and actual event.

At this stage this is a working document and details may be subject to change until we receive additional information from the organisers.

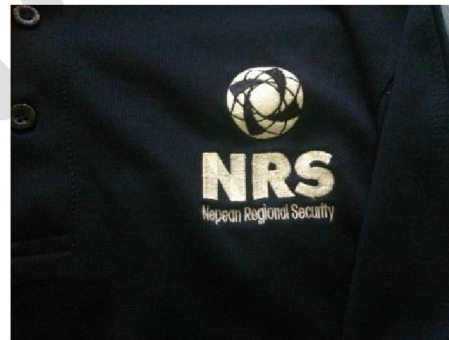
Scope

All perimeter mobile patrol services will be conducted in fully marked security vehicles which will provide a high presence of security externally and internally up to the actual entry area of the event check-in area itself.



Uniforms

All security personnel will be uniformed in compliant security uniforms and hi-vis vest which will provide the high presence of security services.



Duty Information

Eastern Patrol Team

The duty of the Eastern patrol team is to patrol the area around the media road, from adjacent to Gate C, around past the start tower and around to the Eastern bridge – (see map). This also includes monitoring areas at the eastern end of the competition lake.

The patrol team is checking that there are no persons attempting to gain access to the event site via the eastern end of the venue or via the water.

The Eastern team also observes the water area near the Start Tower for people that have entered the water from that end.

Perimeter Patrols

- Car 1

External patrol of streets surrounding the venue, including; Mulgoa Road, Castlereagh Road, McCarthys Lane

- Car 2

Internal patrol of southern bank car park areas and venue fence line, and external areas around Old Castlereagh Road and Leland Street

The perimeter cars are:

- Monitoring for breaks in the venue fence line
- Monitoring that there are no persons attempting to gain access to the venue or event site other than through authorised access points.
- Monitoring that there are no persons in the eastern end of the competition and warm up lakes.
- Monitoring for anti -social behaviour
- Monitoring for any illegal activities

Eastern Bridge Guard

This position is for the purpose of authorised access control.

These guards are also required to be monitoring for people attempting to access the event site.

Venue Gates

This position is for the purpose of asset protection and observing/detecting anti- social behaviour, and unauthorised access.

Eastern Team

This team patrols the Southern bank and up to the Eastern Bridge area – This is usually conducted in a golf cart. The golf cart allows accessibility into the bush land areas and for the purpose of going off the main track.



Toilet block guard

The toilet block guard is located on the Western toilet block .This position is required to stop people from entering the Western Toilets and jumping the fences, which encourage festival goers to attend the toilet area in the actual enclosed entry area which is heavily policed with dogs and security personnel.

Security Manager

The purpose of the security manager is to oversee the security personnel, communicate with stakeholders and be available to make critical decisions at that level if required.

Communications

The major form of communication during the event will be via the use of two way radios. Each guard will be in radio contact with the Security Manager. The Security Manager will also have an additional radio which will allow communication with the Event Organisers, Venue Management and Event Control.

All incidents will be recorded by the nominated event control person taking the radio calls.
