

STATEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS ST MARYS

Bump IN: 23/09/2019

Bump Out: 13/10/2019

Toilets: If no toilets are provided on the grounds we will hire 4 portable toilets from a local contractor and they will be contracted to service these units while on site as required.

Environmental Statement: Due to the temporary nature and structure of the occupation at the site, Webers Circus will make minimal environmental impact. No impact will be made to flora or fauna whilst we are on this site all rubbish is collected and removed from the area before our departure.

Waste – Water Disposal: All grey water is collected from the caravans and then emptied into the onsite toilets which are serviced as required.

Black – Water Disposal: Waste from caravan receptacles is emptied into the portable toilets hired (If no toilets are provided) and serviced by local contractors as required.

Disposal of Rubbish: We engage the services of a local waste disposal company when no bins are supplied, who provide us with a 3 cubic metre bulk rubbish bin and service them as required. We also have 240 litre rubbish bins that are in the foyer tent, and big top, that are emptied daily.

General Clean Up: All rubbish generated from the performance and caravans is placed into the receptacle provided and emptied as required by the engaged local company if applicable.

Designated Camping Areas: As per site Layout all staff and performers have Mobile Homes and Caravans that they travel in from site to site, there is a total of Sixteen (16) Caravans, Eight (8) trucks, Three (3) Semis and Seven (7) cars.

We have a total of Twenty-eight (28) staff members and performers that will be staying on site in the Caravans and Mobile Homes each night and day of the show.

The cars and trucks are used to transport the equipment and the caravans, but remain stationary whilst on site.

Alcohol: No Alcohol will be available for sale from Webers Circus.

Food: We do sell pre packaged fairy floss, potato chips and ice creams. Popcorn is made on site with a Popcorn Machine. Individually packaged pies and sausage rolls are purchased, and stored frozen, and then placed in a pie oven, to warm, before the session. Canned soft drinks are used, and all items are stored in a refrigerated van during travel and then are placed in the refrigerators in the Foyer.

Insurance: Public liability Insurance is held with Lloyds of London for 20 million dollars.

Traffic Management: With regards to Traffic Management the Show is not expected to generate more than 60 vehicles thus rating us as a 'Small Event'.

We have staff members who are delegated parking attendants and control parking before and after each show. Our Parking Staff patrol the site during the show for security checks to all the vehicles.

Noise Control: Webers is very conscious of our patrons and the surrounding neighbours. Noise generated from the performances is minimal and our sound system operates at 45DBA. The

generator used to power the performances is silent and encased to further reduce the effects of noise. The sound system operates at show performance times only approximately 2 hours.
