We continued to keep the Loritz Circus standard high and over the past 2 years we have had an all International artist base performing and travelling with us. Our new production will feature Wheel of death, Globe of Death, clowns, juggling, Aerial acts and much more.

Our entire outfit consists of 15 caravans, 3 semis, trucks and cars. To minimise the impact on the ground, we generally place caravans in line around the tent and minimise driving on site also.

We have 9 Miniature Ponies and 1 Welsh Pony, who all travel with Loritz Circus.

Requests if possible:

- **Power**; if power is available onsite we would prefer to organise the use of town power, alternatively we do have our own 90KVA Silent Generator which we could use.
- Water; if there was any access to water around the site, alternatively we could use a standpipe through local council
- Car Parking; if there is car parking available on site for patrons to use?
- Space; We would require approximately 90m x 100, to ensure we have ample space

You can correspond with any other councils we have previously shown at; they will inform you of the tidy manner we have left the grounds and the conduct of the business once we are in town.

We pride ourselves on being a tidy and professional circus. We work with council and site owners, not against them. If you require any further information, please contact me via email and III happily send through any information you need.
